1. Major Programmes with Concentration(s)/Stream(s)

(a) Students of the following major programmes who would like to declare concentration(s)/stream(s) should make the declaration under CUSIS with reference to their major study scheme.

- Anthropology (applicable to students admitted in 2018-19 and thereafter)
- Contemporary China Studies
- Cultural Management
- Economics
- English
- Geography and Resource Management
- Global Studies
- Integrated BBA Programme
- Japanese Studies
- LLB
- Psychology
- Religious Studies
- Sociology
- Statistics
- Urban Studies

(b) Students of the major programmes listed below do NOT need to make the declaration under CUSIS. Relevant departments/offices will provide the information directly to the Registration and Examinations Section (RES) for recording in CUSIS. These students should check under CUSIS on or after 9 December 2025 if the relevant information is correct.

- Biomedical Sciences
- Biotechnology, Entrepreneurship and Healthcare Management
- Chemistry
- Earth and Environmental Sciences
- Earth System Science
- Fine Arts
- Food and Nutritional Sciences
- Double Degree Programme of Bachelor of Business Administration (Integrated BBA Programme) and Juris Doctor
- Mathematics
- Physics
- Professional Accountancy
- Risk Management Science

2. Application Period

2 – 24 October 2025

Students should check carefully if concentration/stream is compulsory according to the study scheme of their major programmes. If students do NOT declare concentration/stream as required by their major programme by 24 October 2025, RES will not be able to perform the graduation check for fulfilment of graduation requirements for these students. LATE application will NOT be accepted.

3. Application Procedures under CUSIS (Not applicable to Major Programmes under 1(b))
(Logon CUSIS and select “Application” > “Program-Related Change Application”)

Add Concentration(s)/Stream(s)

(a) Check existing concentration(s)/stream(s)

Students should check their existing concentration(s)/stream(s), if any, under “Profile > My Academics” to consider if change is needed.

(b) Input courses under CUSIS

Students MUST check the course fulfillment of the intended concentration(s)/stream(s) by referring to the study scheme(s) under the [Undergraduate Student Handbook](#), and input courses that they have already taken for the concentration(s)/stream(s). Students’ applications will only be approved by the Department/programme office if they have already completed/are close to completing all the course requirements. Department/programme office may also enquire students’ course history to check if all courses have been taken.

(c) Students of the Global Studies Programme MUST declare TWO concentrations while students of Anthropology, Contemporary China Studies, Economics, Geography and Resource Management, Integrated BBA Programme, LLB, Psychology, Sociology and Urban Studies Programmes may declare up to TWO concentrations/streams according to their study schemes. Other Major Programmes allow ONE concentration/stream only.

Change Concentration(s)/Stream(s)

Students who wish to change from one concentration/stream to another one (e.g. from Marketing to Big Data and Quantitative Marketing) should **CHOOSE** “Change Concentration” instead of “Add” under CUSIS. Follow the above steps (a) and (b).

Cancel Concentration(s)/Stream(s)

Students who wish to cancel a declared concentration should choose “Drop Concentration”. No further approval is necessary.

4. Department Approval

Relevant applications may be reviewed and approved by the department/programme office anytime within the application period. The deadline for approval on CUSIS is 3 November 2025. Students should take the initiative to check their application result on CUSIS.
