Announcement for Enrollment in Modern Languages Courses Summer Session, 2024-2025

1. Enrollment for Modern Languages courses at level 1000 (including ARAB1000, FREN1000, GERM1000, HKSL1000, ITAL1000, KORE1000, RUSS1000, SPAN1000, and THAI 1000)

The courses listed above are for beginners only. Students with prior knowledge should contact the language programme teachers to take a placement test. 2. Waiting List for Modern Languages courses (including courses prefixed ARAB, FREN, GERM, HKSL, ITAL, KORE, RUSS, SPAN, and THAI)

If you are on the CUSIS waiting list for the above-listed courses, attend all classes during the add/drop period as you may get a seat if someone drops the course. If you no longer want to take the course(s), remove your name from the waiting list to avoid unexpected enrollment. Note that CUSIS waitlist information will be removed after the April registration period since summer courses are optional. Students must re-add the intended course during the add/drop period if they still wish to enroll.

3. Enrollment in Modern Languages courses by Research Postgraduate Students

Research postgraduate students (i.e., M.Phil./Ph.D. students) interested in enrolling in the above-listed Modern Languages courses must obtain special approval from the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages. Applications can be submitted by completing the “CS-1 Form” (available on the Graduate School Office website) and sending it either by email to lin@cuhk.edu.hk or in person to the General Office of our Department, located at G17, Leung Kau Kui Building, The Chinese University of Hong Kong.

For those research postgraduate students taking Modern Languages courses to satisfy the third language requirement, applications via the CS-1 form will be accepted from 6 May 2025 to 16 May 2025.

For research postgraduate students enrolling in Modern Languages courses without the intent to fulfill the third language requirement, applications will be accepted from 7 May 2025 to 16 May 2025.

Class vacancies will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
