Notes:

1. Refers to qualification obtained prior to admission. Other qualifications not listed here to be considered on an individual basis.
2. For a particular pre-admission qualification in a specific subject (e.g. Grade 5 or above in Social and Cultural Anthropology in IB (HL)), course/unit exemptions will only be granted once (e.g. for ANTH1010, but not again for CURE1009).
3. Subjects include History, History of Europe and Middle East, History of Asia and Oceania, History of the Americas, or other relevant History subjects.
4. Unit exemption is NOT applicable to students admitted to the Professional Accountancy programme (PACC) as they are required to complete DOTE1030, DOTE1040 and ACCT2111 in order to be eligible to apply for registering as students of the Qualification Programme under the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA) or to take other professional examinations. Students should take note that for graduates to be eligible to apply for registering as students of the Qualification Programme under HKICPA or to take other professional examinations, they are required to complete the courses DOTE1030, DOTE1040 and ACCT2111 (ACCT2111 is equivalent to ACCT1111 or HTMG1111).
5. Students with the required grades may be granted unit exemption subject to approval of the Faculty of Medicine on a case-by-case basis.
6. GCE-AL/IAL Chemistry B (Salters) will not be considered as equivalent to GCE Chemistry (AL).
7. Biology B will not be considered for exemption for LSCI1002.
8. Students majoring in Economics or Global Economics and Finance who have obtained (i) Grade B or above in GCE Mathematics (AL/IAL) and Grade B or above in GCE Further Mathematics (AL); or (ii) Grade B or above in GCE Mathematics (AL/IAL) and Grade B or above in GCE Pure Mathematics (AL) are not allowed to take this course. For these students, the number of major required units will be reduced by 2.
9. Students with the required grades may be granted unit exemption subject to approval of School of Journalism and Communication on an individual basis.
10. Students with Associate Degree/ Higher Diploma in Social Work will be eligible for the exemption.
